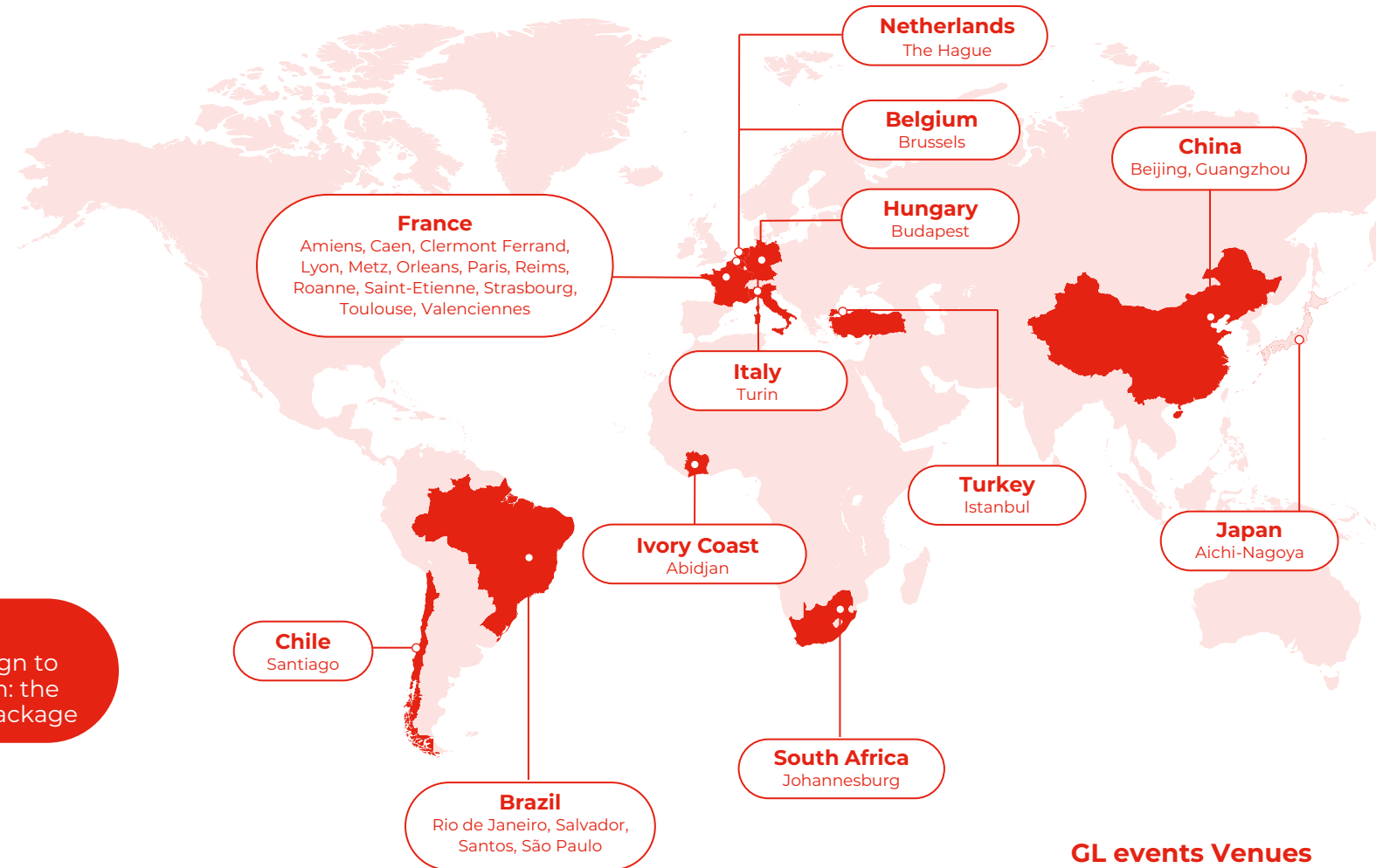

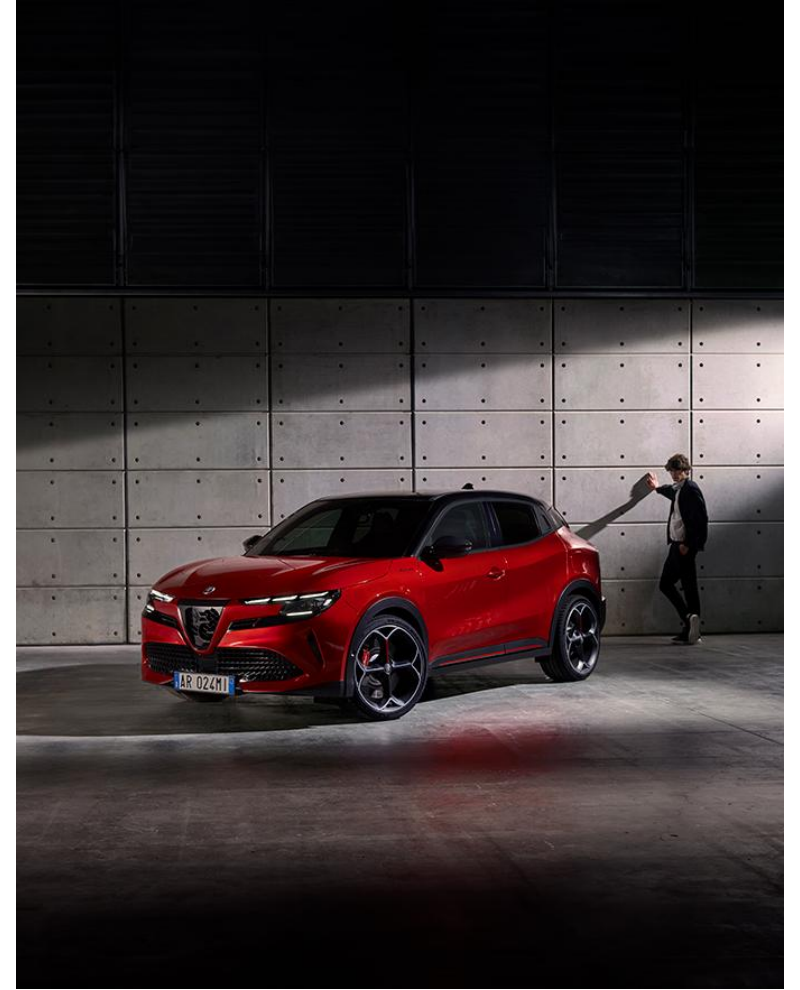
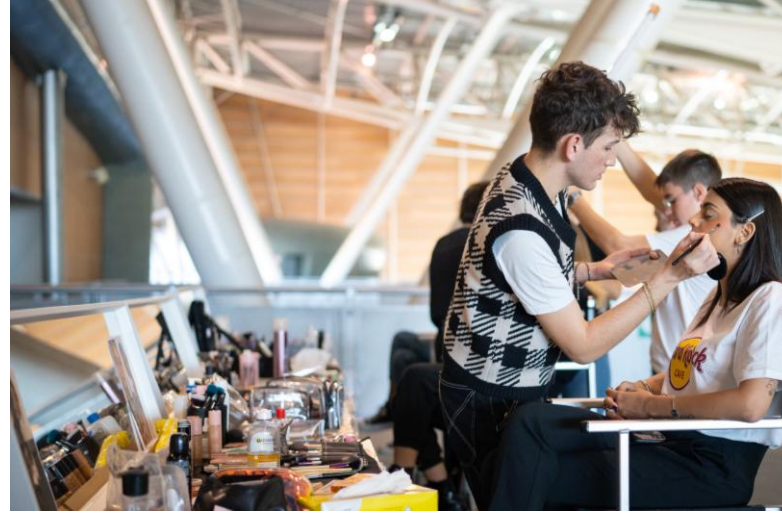
Lingotto Studios is the key location for film and television productions in Turin, Italy's **first capital of Italian cinema**.

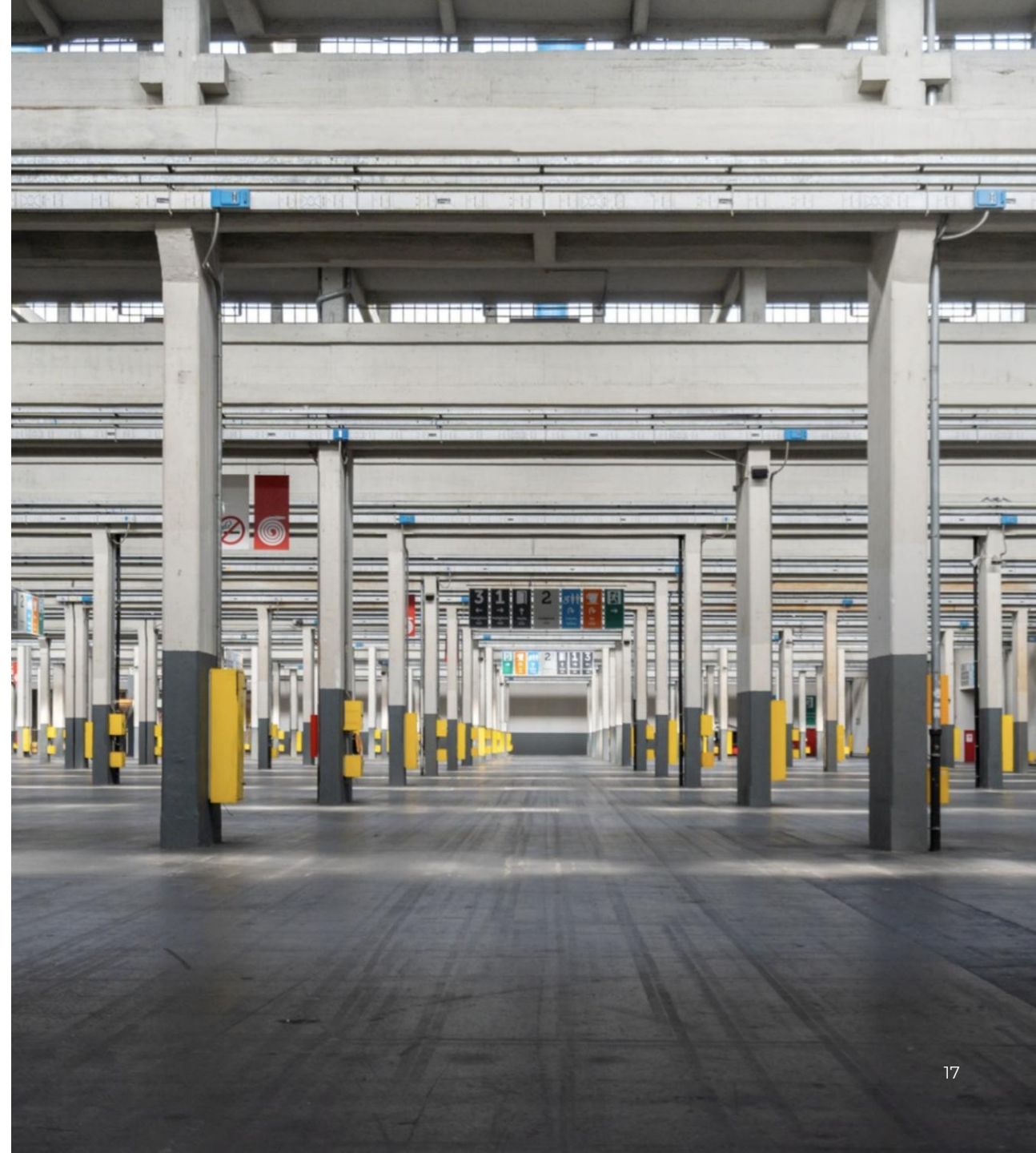

The architectural value

A **multifunctional hub** that also houses businesses, companies and universities, once an iconic car manufacturing plant.

Originally built in 1922 as the headquarters of the FIAT factory, the Lingotto industrial archaeology complex underwent a reconversion in the 1990s; the project entrusted to architect **Renzo Piano** gave rise to a **multifunctional district**.

The three original pavilions were later joined by the **Oval**, a building constructed on the occasion of the XX Olympic Winter Games, to host speed skating competitions on ice. Designed by Studio Zoppini Associati in collaboration with John Barrow (HOK Sport Ltd.) and the British studio Buro Happold, the Oval is one of the largest and brightest single-floor pavilions in Italy.

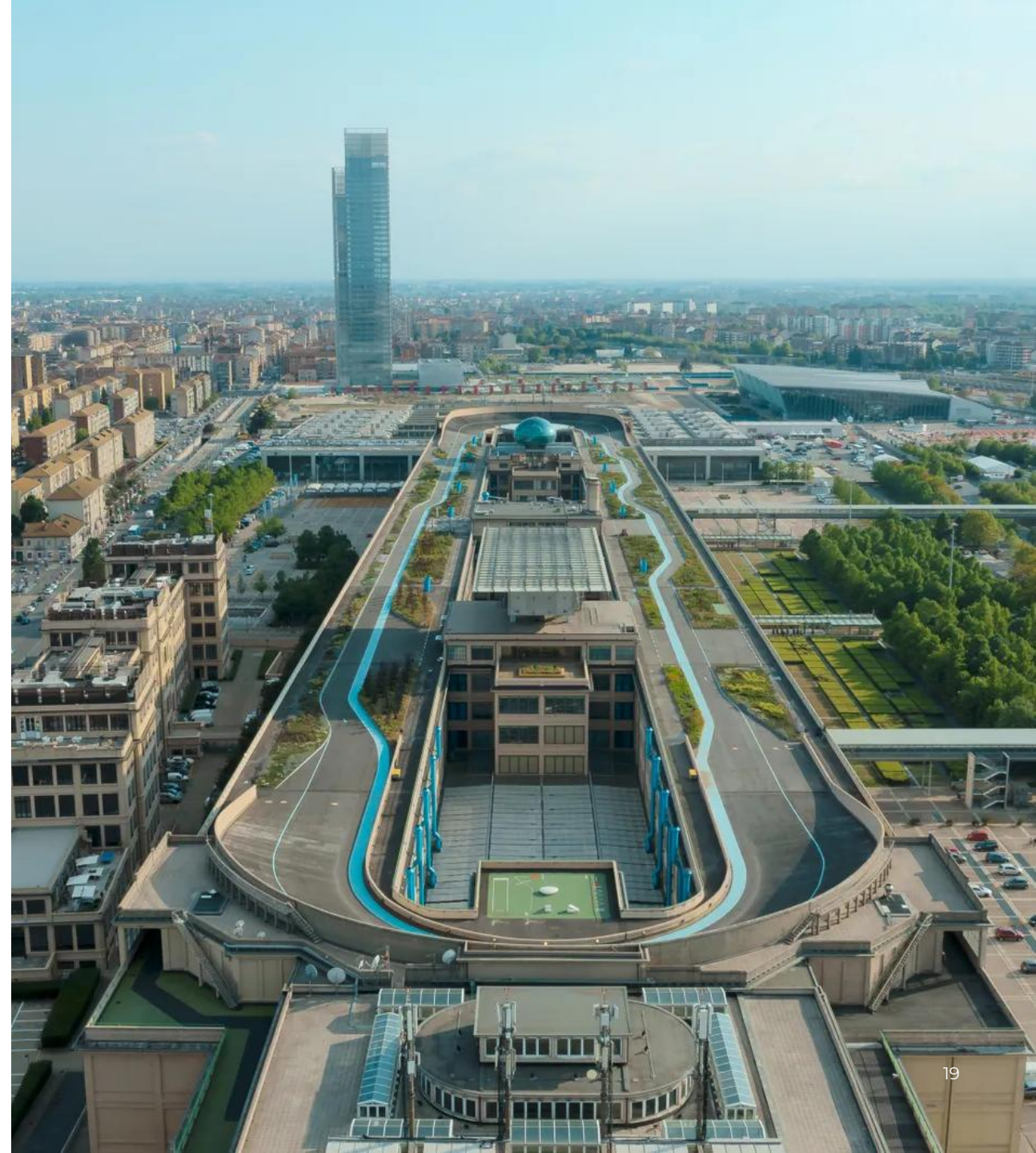
Modularity and accessibility

A **versatile space** that can adapt to every need

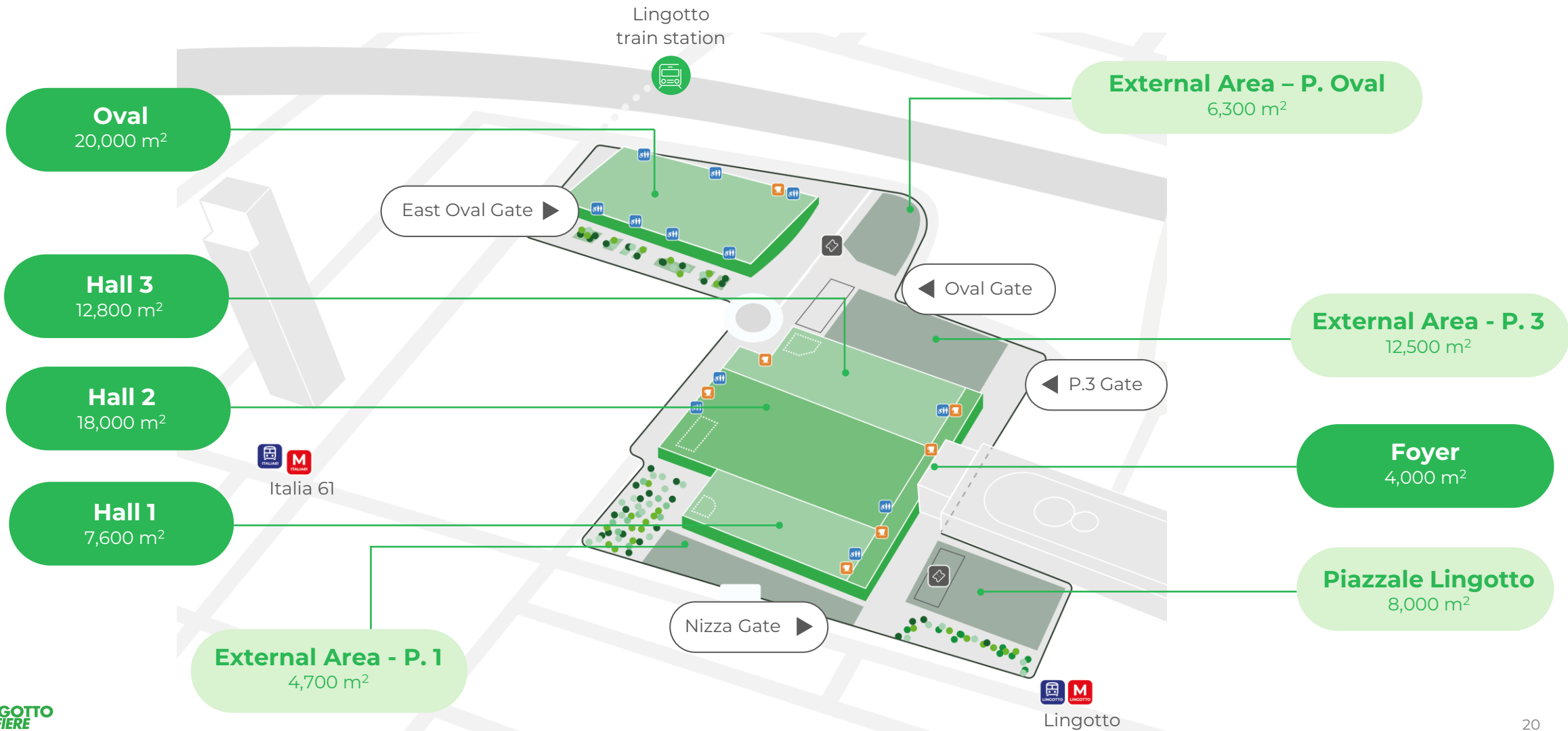
The spaces are modular and can be combined and segmented strategically. They include **4 pavilions** and **3 outdoor areas**, with a total area of **60,000 m² indoors** and **30,000 m² outdoors**.

The pavilions present **complementary surfaces** varying from 7,620 m² in Hall 1 to 20,000 m² in the Oval, and heights varying between 10 m and 18 m, partly supported by pillars, partly completely clear.

The large **outdoor areas** are easily accessible to heavy vehicles and offer space for the activation of services such as shuttles for guests or the public. In addition, **800 parking spaces for personnel** and up to **3,300 parking spaces for visitors** are available.

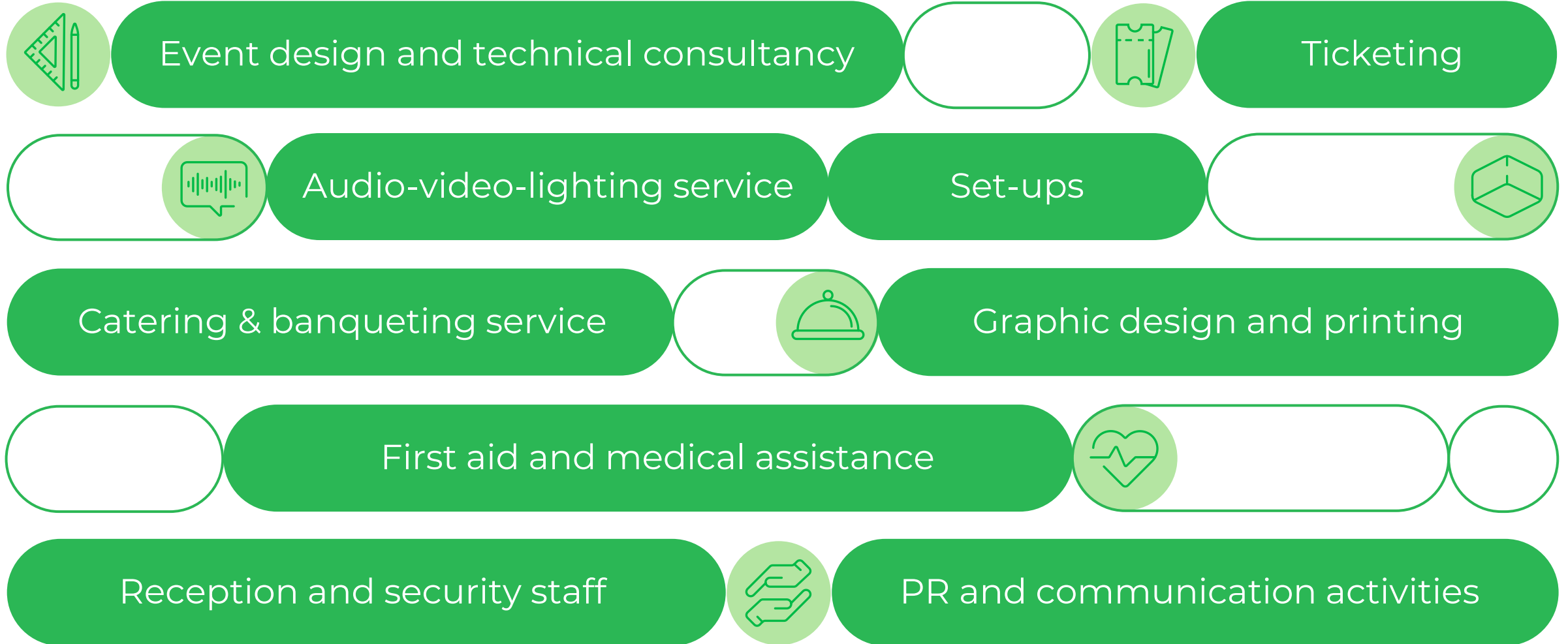

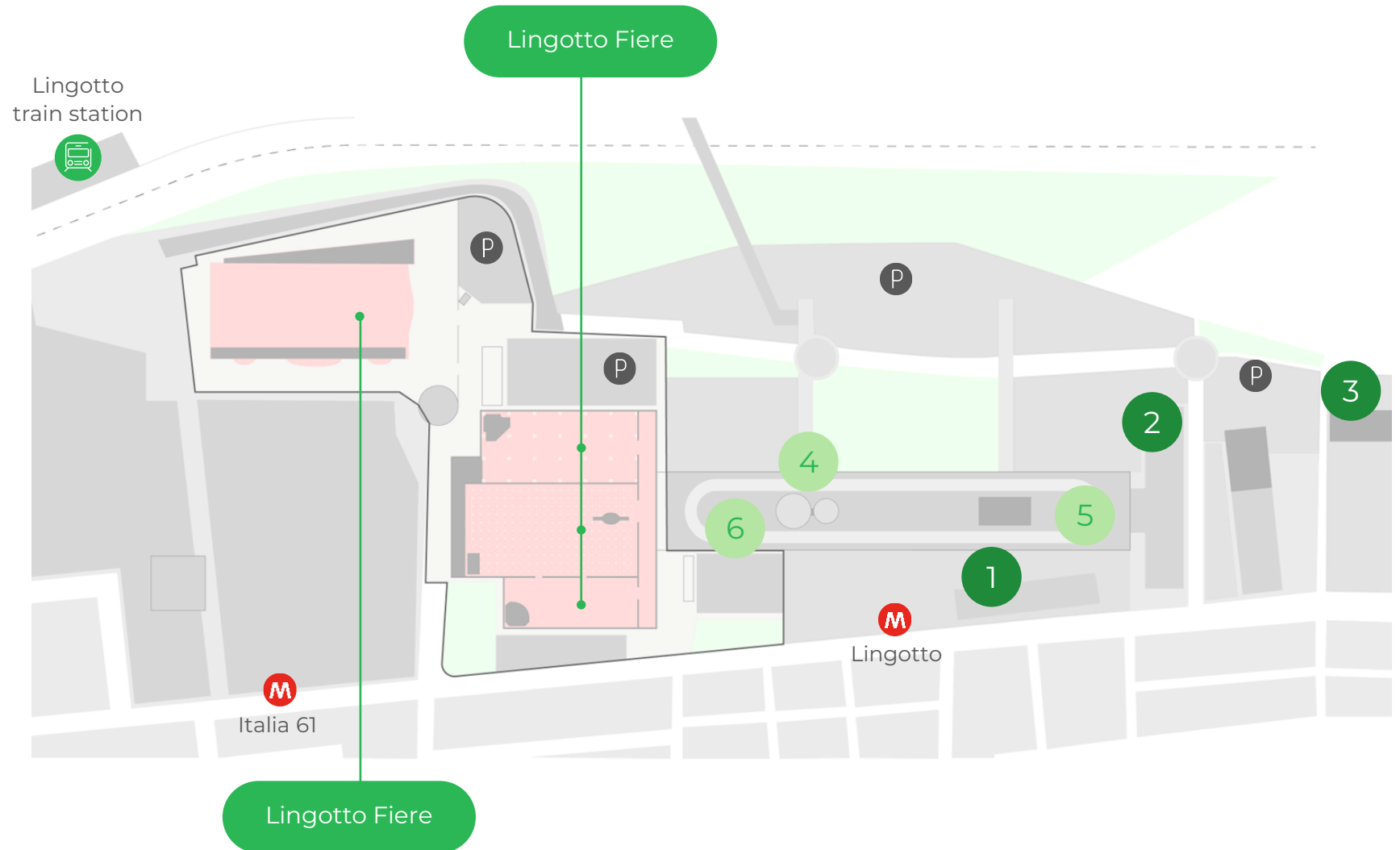

A **central** and easily accessible **location**

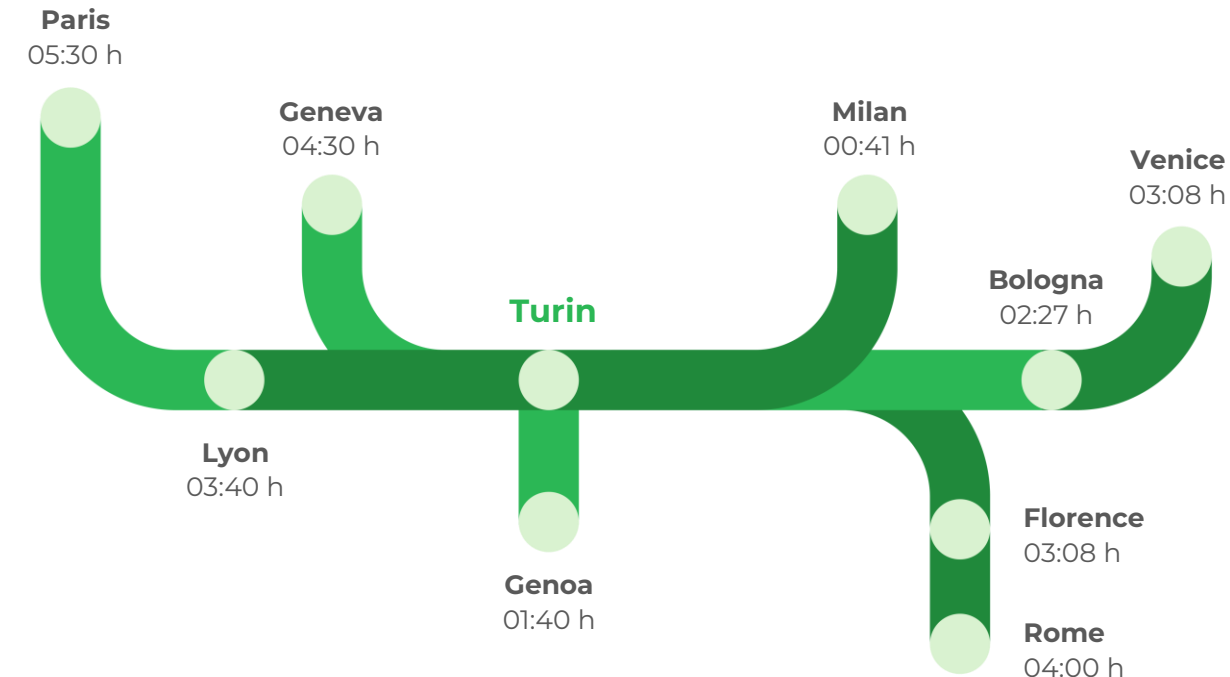
Lingotto Fiere is an important node in **Turin's public transport network**: the venue can be reached by metro, bus and train.

By **car**, Lingotto Fiere is only 35 minutes away from **Turin Caselle airport** and 1.5 hours from **Milan Malpensa airport**, served by domestic and intercontinental flights.

Thanks to its strategic location at the crossroads of Western and Southern Europe and the region's rich infrastructure, Turin is easily accessible from many **European cities** - not just by **airplane**, but also by high-speed **trains**.

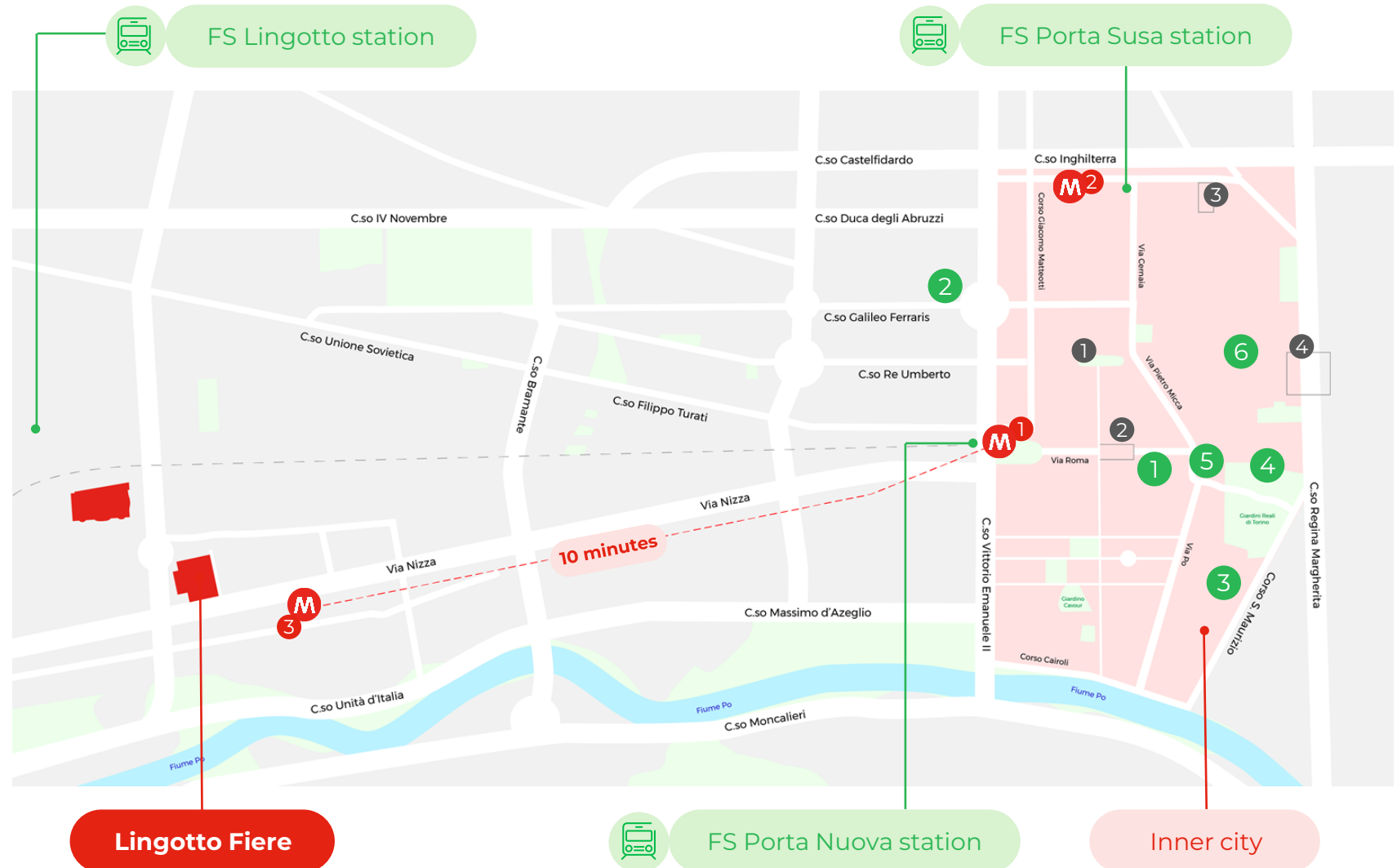

Piemonte is one of the most attractive regions in Italy for **foreign investments**, with an increase of over 80% in the last few years.

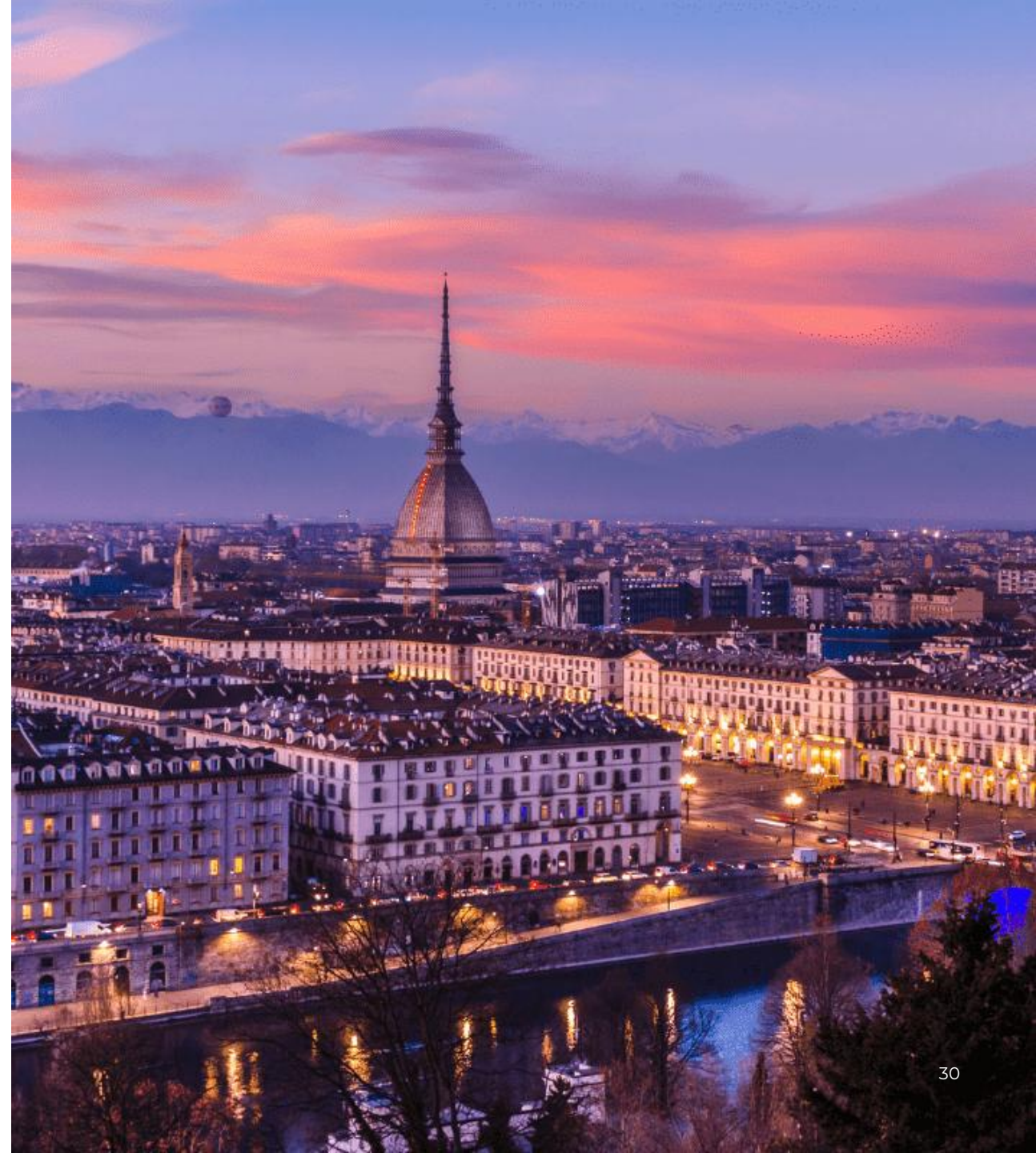


The cultural vibrancy

The quality of Piedmontese **enogastronomic offerings** enriches the visitor experience.



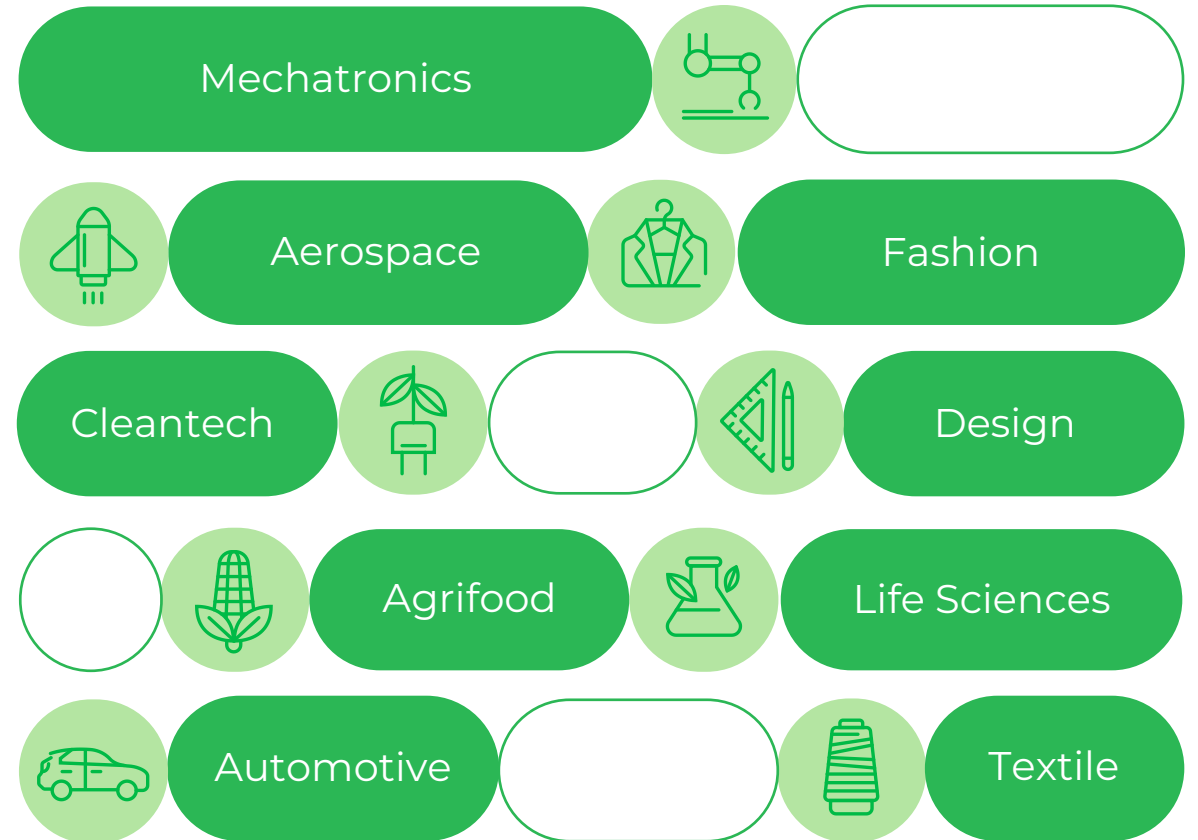
